A Public Hearing regarding the Establishment of a Local Law for the Town of Charlton opting out of allowing Cannabis Retail Dispensaries and Onsite Cannabis Consumption sites in the Town of Charlton as authorized under Cannabis Law, Article 4, will begin at 7:30p.m.

A Public Hearing regarding the expenditure of funds from the Town of Charlton Parks Repair Reserve Fund for tree removal services in Gideon Hawley Park will begin at 7:35p.m.

A Public Hearing regarding the expenditure of funds from the Town of Charlton Parks Repair Reserve Fund for Survey work at Mill Pond Park will begin at 7:40p.m.

Pursuant to Section 6-d of the General Municipal law of New York State, the Town Board gives notice that the Town Board proposes to appropriate the sum of \$4,000.00 from the Town of Charlton Parks Repair Reserve Fund to be used for tree removal services in Gideon Hawley Park, and to appropriate the sum of \$18,000.00 for survey work in Mill Pond Park.
