**Regarding the expenditure of funds from the Parks Repair Reserve Fund  
for the Town of Charlton**

The Town Clerk read the following Legal Notice and confirmed that it was published in the official newspaper, The Daily Gazette on July 13th, 2019:

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING  
THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE PARKS REPAIR  
RESERVE FUND FOR THE TOWN OF CHARLTON**

Pursuant to Section 6-d of the General Municipal law of New York State, the Town Board gives notice that the Town Board proposes to appropriate the sum of \$13,000.00 from the Town of Charlton Parks Repair Reserve Fund to be used to improve and construct a handicap accessible trail way from Town Hall to the Gideon Hawley Park gazebo, and, the Town Board is required to hold a public hearing with respect to the expenditure of such funds.

A public hearing will be held by the Town Board at 7:15 p.m. on August 12, 2019 at the Town Hall, 758 Charlton Road, Charlton, New York regarding the expenditure of funds from the Town of Charlton Parks Repair Reserve Fund, at which time all persons desiring to be heard thereon will be heard.

Supervisor Grattidge explained that the Reserve Fund is funded by a lot fee when land is subdivided and a new building lot is created. The money is set aside to be used for the upkeep of our Town Parks. Councilman Grasso said that the Town received a \$5,000 grant from Saratoga County for the project so the net cost to the Town is \$8,000.00. When the grant money is received, it will be deposited into the Reserve Fund.
