PUBLIC HEARING Regarding the expenditure of funds from the Parks Repair Reserve Fund for the Town of Charlton

May 22, 2017 6:45 PM

The Public Hearing for the proposed expenditure of funds from the Parks Repair Reserve Fund was held at 6:45 pm at the Charlton Town Hall, and called to order by Supervisor Grattidge.

Present: Councilman Grasso, Councilman Heritage, Councilman Hodgkins, Supervisor Grattidge, Town Clerk Brenda Mills, Attorney Van Vranken.

Supervisor Grattidge opened the Hearing with introduction of the Board members. He stated that the reason for the Hearing is that the Board wishes to have projects done in Elmer Smith Park which include resurfacing of the tennis courts and electrical work, estimated at \$19,000. He explained that the money is in a special reserve account and comes from a fee charged when land is subdivided. The State requires that a public hearing be held and a resolution be passed in order to remove money from the account.

Town Clerk Mills read the following Legal Notice and confirmed that it was published in the official newspaper, The Daily Gazette on Thursday, May 11, 2017:
