Thank you for continuing to consult with the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the provided documentation in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. These comments are those of the SHPO and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources. They do not include other environmental impacts to New York State Parkland that may be involved in or near your project.

We have review the additional scope of work documentation including the Thaler Reilly Wilson proposal, dated November 8, 2023. As noted, the Charlton Community Center is listed in the State and National Registers of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the Charlton Historic District.

Based on this review, it is the opinion of the SHPO that the proposed project will have No Adverse Effect to historic resources. If there are any substantive changes to the currently proposed scope of work, consultation with our office should resume.
