The Agenda Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Charlton, Saratoga County, New York was held at the Charlton Town Hall, 758 Charlton Rd, Charlton, NY and called to order by Councilman Grasso at 7:56 p.m. to set the agenda for the April 13th meeting.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Councilman Grasso said that he signed a State of Emergency declaration on March 19, 2020. (document on next page). This declaration gives the Town the authority at a local level to change any policies or procedures that would typically be done through our Organizational Resolution regarding staffing, office hours, how we conduct meetings, etc.. This does not give us the right to change anything that has been adopted or in place at the State, Federal or County level. It is only for the Town level. This gives the Town Board a blanket authority to conduct business without having to meet as a Board and do things through resolutions. The Town Attorney recommended this decision be ratified as a Town Board, and not just one member's decision. Councilman Robbins said that he feels that it is good to have in place, in case anything happens and the virus continues to escalate.

The Town Hall is now closed to the public during business hours. Business should be conducted by phone, email, drop box and appointment only. We have cancelled the meetings of various Boards and Committees until a later date. Town Court closed until May 1st. Councilman Grasso said that people are questioning if Party in the Park will be cancelled. He recommended that the Board wait a little while before making the decision.

The training class for Kevin Hart as new Town Justice has been cancelled.

All Charlton Seniors activities, meetings and exercise classes are cancelled until May 1.

TOWN OF CHARLTON STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Charlton effective March 16, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared for the entire Town of Charlton due to the following:

1. Outbreak and spread of COVID-19 virus, accelerating at an alarming pace, with reports of cases in the County of Saratoga increasing each day. In order to protect the Town residents, employees, and the public health and safety, emergency action is necessary to help slow and arrest the rapid spread of this virus, including reducing the opportunity for instances in which individuals come in close contact with one another.

These situations threaten the public safety.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty (30) days or until rescinded, modified or extended by a subsequent order or resolution.

As the Deputy Town Supervisor of the Town of Charlton, I, JOE GRASSO, exercise the authority given me under Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the Town of Charlton to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, the public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary and proper by the Town Board and Town Supervisor.

This declaration may be modified, supplemented, and changed by subsequent orders, declarations and Resolutions.
